(London, 10/6/02) Outcomz Ltd (www.outcomz.com), the payment-by-results business consultancy, today announced the investment of an undisclosed amount in Accommodation for Students (www.accommodationforstudents.com), the UK's most advanced student accommodation search engine. Funding will be used for technical development, particularly e-commerce systems, marketing and partnership recruitment.

Outcomz, who recently announced half-year results of \$1/2 million profit, has a business model which specifically includes selective investments in new start businesses. This is accompanied by senior management input to help fast-track the business.

Ian Hammond, CEO of Outcomz, commented:

“Accommodation for Students is a prime target for investment. It has already made great inroads into the online student accommodation sector with over 1000 unique users a day and is number one in search engine performance. It is also well advanced in its plans to replicate its powerful search engine in

other accommodation areas. The first reuse of the AFS engine is 'Accommodation for Ryder Cup' (www.rydercup-housing.com) which went live in April 2002. Response has been good and this will be the first of a steady roll out of similar sites - each focusing on niche markets."

Accommodation for Students' website offers the best facilities for both students and landlords. Students, via a user-friendly GUI and powerful search engine, can specify property requirements from the widest accommodation criteria available, even down to the provision of satellite TV. Landlords have their own admin suite that allows them to upload and edit properties directly. Uniquely, they can measure their performance in terms of student hits, enquiries, viewings etc - and the service is free for a trial period.

Accommodation for Students director, William Berry, said:

"The investment by Outcomz will help us take full advantage of our excellent performance since launch. We will use the funds to invest in a good e-commerce platform. We can also now more aggressively pursue our marketing programme both in terms of extensive landlord emailing campaigns and high quality selective online and offline advertising. We are also talking to a number of large, prestigious, high-profile brands with a view to extending our reach.

However, it's not just the financial investment that's important. Outcomz's advice and hands-on interest in our development has been invaluable in helping us move the business forward quickly."

Accommodation for Students was recently selected by Virgin Mobile to advertise their current Big Red House student promotion. The site, built by net121.com (www.net121.com), the specialist in database driven websites, also recently received a Highly Commended Certificate in the Best Industry Innovation category of the inaugural Property Business Awards. Outcomz' and its associates' clients include ICL, Echo Plc, Tesco and Boots.

- Chatroom to allow potential housemates to talk to each other and review house options.

- Sophisticated, user-friendly '**landlord admin suite**' which allows landlords to directly upload and edit their property details and pictures on the Accommodation for Students website. The unique

measurement facility allows landlords to judge the effectiveness of the website in attracting student interest to their properties and ultimately their letting.

- Easy contact system: Accommodation for Students '**email landlord service**'. This service enables students to send a generic email of interest to a landlord with one click. This also ensures the privacy of landlord email addresses.
